Now, you have to draft an article about Cheung Chau Bun Festival.

Text Type: Article  Reader(s): School magazine readers 

Tone: Semi-formal  Tense(s): Present & past tenses 

- What is the title of the article?
- When is the festival held each year?
- What is the origin of the festival?

Think of a catchy title.

(title)

Cheung Chau Bun Festival is held from (date)

Why was the festival started? You can refer to P.69 for ideas.

(origin / reason)

- What do people do at this festival?
- How do they feel?

Is the festival popular?

Introduce the first activity and people's feelings about it.

People do a lot of things to celebrate this festival.

(first activity & feelings)

Then write about another activity.

- What festive food do people eat?
- Can you describe the food (e.g. flavour, size, colour, shape, special features)?
- Does the food have any symbolic meanings?

You may write about the food using these patterns:

Does the food carry any special meanings (e.g. wealth, happiness)?

- What do people think about the festival in general?
- Can you encourage the readers to join the festival?
