Part B (7 marks)

Answering multiple-choice questions (MCQ) in a test is tricky, but there  are certain things that you should know about this type of questions. Most options in MCQs contain words copied from the text. Since teachers want students to relate words with similar meaning, those options with the same words in the text are most likely not the answer. It is also a good idea to subtract the wrong information given in the choices. Last but not least, teachers usually have a preference on certain options, so after the first test, you will know for sure. Try to make a guess even if you do not know the answer. You should have 25 percent of getting the right answer when you guess even if you know nothing about it. If you can make intelligent guesses, you should be able to do much better than that.
